## 3. Three routes for AS & A Levels

#### There are three routes for cambridge international AS & A Levels

- Route 1: AS Level only- students take the AS Levels in the same series.
- Route 2: A Level staged over two years students take AS components in year 1 and A2 components in year 2.
- Route 3: A Level over one year students take the full A Level ( AS & A2 ) components in the same series.

# Phofs Academy offers all these three routes and the route that the student can take is determined by student's capabilities, aspirations and academic background:

- Phofs Academy offers route 1to the students who aspire to study with universities that accept AS Level qualifications as equivalent to grade 12 such as those in South Africa, Egypt, the USA, Canada etc.
- Phofs Academy offers route 2 & 3 to the students who aspire to study with universities that accept full A-Level qualifications, such as those in the UK and other European countries, New zealand, Singapore, and Australia, or who want to gain admissions advantage into competitive programs in universities that accept AS-Level.

## The choice between routes 2 & 3 depends on how well the students passed their GCSE/ O-Level/ grade 10-11

- Route 2 is offered to any students who passed grade 11/GCSE/ O-Level (IGCSE, LGCSE, BGCSE, EGCSE, ZIMSEC O-Level etc.) Or students from grade 10 who obtained exceptional results.
- < Route 3 is offered to students who obtained exceptional results from grade 11/GCSE/O-Level (IGCSE, LGCSE, BGCSE, EGCSE, ZIMSEC O-Level etc.).

## 4. Learning model and Assessment

#### Live classroom model

PHOFS ACADEMY uses advanced videocomferencing technology that transport students into fully interactive time-tabled online classrooms which enables teachers to see all their students and the students to see their classmates and teachers. Just like in the offline school, the needs of the lesson guide the form/structure that online classroom can take. Students can raise their hands to speak to teachers and peers and be asked to work through specific examples, share their work or lead the class and many more.

#### Flipped classroom model (recorded models + live seminars)

In addition, to live lessons, Phofs Academy conducts as live discussion seminars to deepen students' understanding of subject materials. Students prepare a day before discussion seminars by watching recorded lessons and reading additional materials that will influence their discussions.

#### **Science experiments**

Phofs Academy offer its students vitual biology, Chemistry and physics labs- providing students with learning experiences equivalent to those with physical resources. Our vitual lab activities are conducted using video demonstrations and online simulations. Simple lab activities are conducted by students at home using everyday objects.

#### **Internal Assessments**

All formative assessments and preparatory examinations at Phofs Academy are taken online under remote exam proctoring. The authenticity of students' assignments and projects is verified using the latest antiplagiarism tools. Phofs Academy provides regular reports reflecting subjects marks and aggregates just as in traditional schools.

#### **External Assessments**

External examinations required to complete AS and A levels qualifications are set by CAIE examining or awarding body and are taken at the physical exam centre (British council or CAIE registered centre). Students will register and pay applicable exam fees to sit for an external exam. They will be allocated the closest British council or a CAIE-registered exam centre in their areas to sit for an external exam.

### 5. Admissions

PHOFS ACADEMY follows two academic calender years: February - November and September - June.

Applications for February 2025 enrolment are now open until 25 January 2025. PHOFS ACADEMY affers day school and evening school enrolment options.

Phofs academy admits students of any race, colour, ethnic origin sex, age, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity, including those who have special educational needs and disabilities, if the academy can meet their needs.

#### **Applicable discounts**

## 10. Application Procedure

\*Scholarship applications will be evaluated in two batches based on the dates of application.

Results for batch one. (those who submitted before 30 November, 2024) will be announced on 16 December, 2024.

On January 24, 2025 batch 2 (those who submitted between 1 December 2024 and 20 January 2025) will be made available.

\*Orientation (Technology induction and timetable reviews) will take place on the 3 to 4 of February 2025. The classes start on the 5 February 2025.
